## ❶ Academics

- Teaching is based on Malaysian National Syllabus which is Kurikulum Standard Sekolah Menengah (KSSM) for Form 1–5.
- National examinations conducted are Pentaksiran Tingkatan 3 (PT3) and Sijil Pelajaran Malaysia (SPM).
- Mathematics and Science are taught in English for Form 1–5.
- As part of an Enrichment Programme offered in WMSS, Forms 1 to 2 students are given enrichment lessons in English, Maths and Science and are taught selected topics from the KSSM and Cambridge IGCSE syllabus.
- All students are encouraged to converse in two main languages — English and Bahasa Melayu.
- The promotion of R & R culture which is Reading & Revision.
- The availability of Online Reading Programme through Scholastic Literacy Pro programme.

## ❷ Accessibility

- Located at the Seremban town centre which is about 200 meters from the main Bus Terminal (Terminal 1) and 500 meters from the KTM Train Station.

- Our school was rated 5-star in 2016 during the inspection of Standard Kualiti Institusi Pendidikan Swasta (SKIPS) by the Kementerian Pendidikan Malaysia.
